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2. The Gospel Tension

How does he describe the courtroom image of the gospel, and why does he say the verdict is guilty for everyone?

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3. Holding On

What does he mean when he keeps repeating, “hold on for the sentencing,” and how does that reshape the way he wants people to hear bad news and good news together?

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4. Jesus Enduring It All

As he prays through Jesus' suffering, what parts of the cross and resurrection does he emphasize, and how does that connect to grace and hope?

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5. Early Life in Stockton

What do you notice about Pastor Mike's family background in Stockton, his father as a police officer, his mother as a nurse, and his very limited church exposure?

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6. Favor and the Butcher Job

Why does he treat the job at Gary and Meat Company as a sign of God's favor, and how does the contrast with Big John help him see grace differently?



God's favor isn't fair because he really is he does what he wants, and it doesn't always level the playing field, but his love is always the same.

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7. From Religion to Real Faith

How does his story with Jill, the Adventist church, the Methodist church, and Neil begin to move him from knowing about religion to actually wrestling with faith?

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8. Grace and Growth

He says he understood truth and right-or-wrong before he understood grace; what does that reveal about the difference between rule-keeping and being changed by God's mercy?

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9. Why Pastoring?

What reasons does he give for sensing a call to ministry, and how do service, adoption into God's family, and practical compassion seem to shape his view of pastoring?

How does the conversation about New Hope's multicolored community and everyone's story challenge the idea that only dramatic testimonies matter, and how might that speak to your own life?
