4. Remembering and the Light

What does she say happens when we remember loved ones for just a minute or two, and why is that important for people in grief?



When we remember for just a minute or two, we step back into the light and lift our faces to the light and the warmth once again.

5. Jesus as the Only True Light

How does she distinguish between the people who reflected light and Jesus, the source of that light?



There is only one true light. Jesus said, I am the light of the world.

Why does she say the thief on the cross understood Jesus' mission, and what hope does that give for those who feel unworthy or burdened by guilt?



He promised him that he would be with Jesus in paradise because you see, that was Jesus' mission.

7. No Coattails to Heaven

What does she mean when she says we cannot get to heaven on anyone's coattails, and how does that challenge us after losing godly loved ones?

How does she describe the role of those who are grieving now as the legacy and light left behind by their loved ones?
